BALTIMORE, MD (November 17, 2009) – Coached by Simon Fraser University men's lacrosse Co-Head Coaches Jeff Cathrea and Brent Hoskins, the Burnaby Mountain Selects Junior (1993 born) and Senior (1992 born) Elite fall touring teams travelled to Baltimore, Maryland to compete at the National Recruiting Fall Ball Lacrosse Tournament November 7-8, 2009.

The Selects combined to post a 4-6-2 (.417) record against top club teams from Maryland, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ontario, Pennsylvania and Virginia. The Junior Selects went 3-2-1 (.583) going undefeated on Day 1 before posting a tie with two losses on Day 2. The Senior Selects earned a win and a tie with four losses for a two-day record of 1-4-1 (.250).

VERSUS OPPONENTS

Both Burnaby Mountain teams were matched up against some of the tournament's top competition as they were featured in showcase games versus other elite travel teams in front of over 60 coaches from NCAA college lacrosse programs including NCAA Division I powerhouses Notre Dame, Princeton and Virginia.

FEATURED ATTRACTIONS

In addition to the two days of competition, the Burnaby Mountain Selects also took time to tour the campus of the US Naval Academy (NCAA Div. I) and visit two of North America's most historic cities: Washington, DC and Manhattan, NY.



At the Navy campus in Annapolis, MD, known as the Yard, the Selects were given an exclusive tour by two retired US Navy Officers that featured a look inside the Lejeune Physical Education Center, Dahlgren Hall and Buchanan House (residence of the Superintendent). The Selects also toured the Naval Academy Chapel and the crypt of the first Navy war hero John Paul Jones (1747-92) before observing the Noon Day Formation in front of Bancroft Hall (Midshipmen Dormitory).

Following their morning at the academy, the Selects traveled to Washington, DC. Highlights of the US Capital included a visit of the White House, Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial and Arlington National Cemetery.

LOOKING FORWARD

Next up for the Burnaby Mountain Selects, the U12 and U13 Elite teams will commence their fall season with an exhibition series in Tacoma, Washington on November 15, 2009. The Sophomore and Junior Selects will then conclude their fall tour dates with a trip back to Baltimore, Maryland to compete in the UP Lax Fall Shootout November 21 and 22.
