## Tri-City players flood field lacrosse Selects

Featuring a bench full of Tri-City players, the Burnaby Mountain Selects Under-12 and U-13 Elite fall field lacrosse touring teams were brilliant when they travelled recently to Tacoma, Wash. to compete in an exhibition series hosted by the South Sound Starz.

The Selects combined to post a 5-2 (.714) record against high school and club teams from Washington state. The U-12 Selects went undefeated posting a 3-0 record, while the U-13 Selects went 2-2 on the day.

The Burnaby Mountain Selects out-scored their opponents by a combined score of 66-18. The U-12 Selects scored an impressive 35 goals in three games while allowing only three goals against. The U-13 Selects used four games to register 31 goals for and 15 goals against.

Playing on the Selects' U-12 squad were Coquitlam's Dylan Chand, Christian Del Bianco and John Hofseth, along with Will Kinnaird of Port Coquitlam and Port Moody's Dylan Kaminski.

Toiling with the U-13 Selects were Coquitlam's Alex Bodin, Joe Dale, Andrew Gallant, Josh Kemp, Michael Lucarino and Eli Salama, plus Port Coquitlam's Dylan De Guevara, Austin Madigan and Mitchell Milani. Also on the unit was Port Moody's Brendan Gauthier.

Established in 2006 by Simon Fraser University men's lacrosse co-coaches Jeff Cathrea and Brent Hoskins, the Burnaby Mountain Selects Field Lacrosse Program is an amateur sports organization designed to train players in a high-performance environment to best prepare them for a collegiate field lacrosse career.

Selection and consideration into the program is reserved for a select group of elite student-athletes who possess the desire to work hard and learn in a competitive team environment, while demonstrating the ability to keep their academic goals in the highest regards.

Over 200 athletes in grades 6-12 have participated in the Selects program from over 20 communities all over B.C.

The Selects travel to compete in top college recruiting tournaments throughout North America, helping to place over 40% of graduating players in collegiate field lacrosse programs.
