## **Burnaby Mountain Selects announce 2009 Fall Rosters and Schedule**

**BURNABY, BC** (October 23, 2009) – Jeff Cathrea & Brent Hoskins, Co-Head Coaches of the Simon Fraser University men's lacrosse team and founders of the Burnaby Mountain Lacrosse Elite Development Program, have announced the 2009 fall rosters and schedule for the Burnaby Mountain Selects Elite Touring Teams. Entering the programs sixth season, Cathrea & Hoskins continue to build one of Canada's top field lacrosse development programs, combining excellence on the field with academic achievement. Burnaby Mountain will field six travel teams this fall: U12 Elite (1997, 1998 born), U13 Elite (1996 born), Freshmen Elite (1995 born), Sophomore Elite (1994 born), Junior Elite (1993 born) and Senior Elite (1992 born). In total, 111 student-athletes from twenty different communities across British Columbia and one US born athlete will represent the Selects at top tournaments in California, Florida, Maryland, North Carolina and exhibition games in Portland and Seattle. Founded in 2006, the Burnaby Mountain Selects program is designed to follow the same collegiate template as the Simon Fraser University men's lacrosse program with the objective of best preparing young student-athletes to play at the NCAA or MCLA collegiate level.

The U12 and U13 fall season will consist of one on-field practice and the opportunity to attend a supervised study hall each week. The eleven-week program will also feature a trip to Seattle on November 15 and Portland November 28-29 for exhibition contests versus regional all-star teams. The U12 and U13 Selects will conclude their season with a trip to San Diego, California January 14-18 to compete at the Adrenaline Challenge against top Middle School and Youth teams.

Burnaby Mountain's high school aged teams (Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior) will practice on-field twice a week and attend three hours of weekly study hall. In addition to an eight-week practice schedule, each team will compete in two top college recruiting tournaments throughout North America. Each tournament will feature elite high-school aged competition from across the continent in addition to the opportunity to play in front of NCAA and MCLA College Coaches.

The Freshmen and Sophomore Selects will kick off the 2009 fall season with a trip to North Carolina October 29-November 2 to compete in the Charlotte Fall Classic. While in NC the Selects will also tour the campuses of NCAA Div I lacrosse powers North Carolina and Duke.

The following weekend, November 5-9, the Junior and Senior Selects will travel to Baltimore, Maryland to compete in the National Recruiting Fall Ball Festival. The trip will also include a day-trip to Washington, DC and a tour of the United States Naval Academy (NCAA Div I).

November 19-23, the Sophomore and Junior teams will return to Baltimore, MD to compete in the Ultimate Performance Lacrosse Fall Shootout. In addition to the two-day tournament, the Selects will tour the campuses of Loyola University (NCAA Div I) and nine-time NCAA Div I National Champion, Johns Hopkins University.

The Freshmen and Senior Selects will conclude their 2009 fall season December 29-January 5 when they travel to Tampa, Florida to compete in the Dick's Sporting Goods NDP Tournament of Champions.
