Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows lacrosse players have joined Burnaby Mountain Selects Elite Touring Teams for the 2010 fall season.

The Burnaby Mountain Selects are widely recognized as one of Canada's top field lacrosse development programs, combining excellence on the field with academic achievement.

Jorden Bloom, a Maple Ridge resident and student at Samuel Robertson Technical, has joined the Junior Elite team as a defenseman.

Other Maple Ridge students have joined the ranks as well; Lyndon Knuttila of Thomas Haney Secondary will play attack on the junior team, and Mateo Le Van, a Highland Park Elementary student, will play on the U12 team.

Two Pitt Meadows Secondary students have also been added to the roster.

Riley Glemnitz will be a midfielder on the sophomore team and Andrew Gresham will play midfield on the freshman team.

Burnaby Mountain will field six travel teams this fall: U12 Elite (1998, 1999 born), U13 Elite (1997 born), Freshmen Elite (1996 born), Sophomore Elite (1995 born), Junior Elite (1994 born) and Senior Elite (grad 2011).

In total, over 120 student athletes from twenty-five different communities across British Columbia and Washington State will represent the Selects at top tournaments in California, Maryland, Nevada, North Carolina and exhibition series in Portland and Tacoma.
