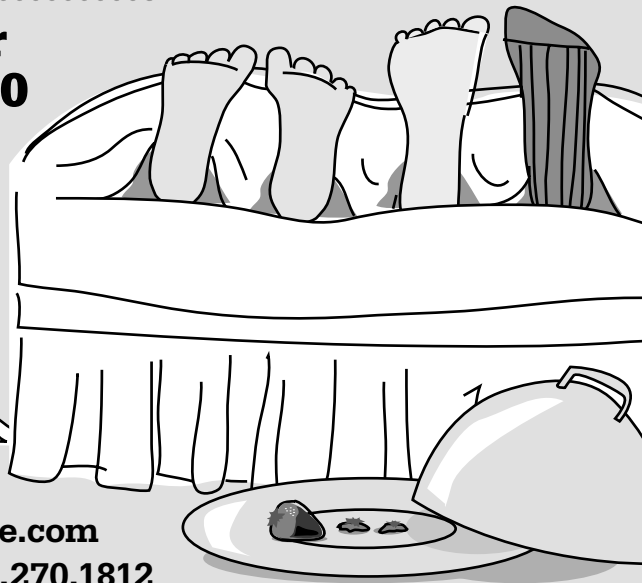

### Plenty of Richmond lacrosse talent selected to play for touring teams

Ten field lacrosse players from Richmond have been selected to play for the Burnaby Mountain Selects (BMS) Elite Touring Teams.

Entering the program's eighth season; the Selects are widely recognized as one of Canada's top field lacrosse development programs, combining excellence on the field with academic achievement. The program is overseen by Jeff Cathrea and Brent Hoskins, co-head coaches of the Simon Fraser University men's lacrosse team.

Burnaby Mountain's high school aged teams (Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior) practice on-field twice a week and attend three hours of weekly study hall. In addition to a three-month practice schedule, each team will compete in two top college recruiting events throughout North America.
