

Selects' lacrosse grad to play for England

Former Burnaby Mountain Selects midfielder James Delaney will play for England at the 2011 World Indoor Lacrosse Championship in Prague, Czech Republic.

Delaney, who attended St. Thomas More, is currently at sophomore at Seton Hill University in Greensburg, Pennsylvania. He scored 25 goals and 18 assists in his freshman season.

Delaney is the second Selects alumnus selected to compete at the Worlds. Brian Gillis will play for Ireland.

England finished fourth at the 2007 World Indoor Championship in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

England, Ireland, Australia, Canada, Czech Republic, Iroquois Nationals, United States and Slovakia will begin play May 21. Canada is the two-time defending champion.
