Mallory scooped in third round

A successful field lacrosse player from Pitt Meadows was drafted to the National Lacrosse League by a team in Washington State.

Former Pitt Meadows Secondary student Mike Mallory was the number 21 pick in the 2011 National Lacrosse League (NLL) entry draft held Sept. 21 in Toronto, Ont.

Mallory was selected in the third round by the NLL's Washington Stealth.

Mallory currently plays junior A box lacrosse for the Delta Islanders where he has been selected as a First Team All-Star in both 2010 and 2011, in addition to being named the 2010 BCJALL Rookie of the Year and 3 Star Award winner.

In 43 regular season games, Mallory has tallied 78 goals and 100 assists for 178 points. He has also registered 19 goals and 19 assists for 38 points in 11 play-off games with the Islanders.

The 6'2", 190-pound Pitt

Meadows native played two seasons with Burnaby Mountain from 2006-2008, helping lead the Selects to successful tournaments in California, Florida, Maryland, and Seattle, including a first place finish at the 2006 Seattle Space Needle Shootout.

A member of the inaugural Burnaby Mountain Selects U18 Elite team, Mallory becomes the first Selects player to be drafted professionally since the inception of the program in 2006.

NLL is North America's professional indoor lacrosse league, featuring the best lacrosse players in the world. Founded in 1987, the league recently completed its 2011 season, the league's 25th anniversary season. Average game attendance is close to 10,000 fans per game, with several games played in front of crowds in excess of 16,000 fans. The NLL has nine teams playing in major markets of the United States and Canada: Buffalo Bandits, Calgary Roughnecks, Colorado Mammoth, Edmonton Rush, Minnesota Swarm, Philadelphia Wings, Rochester Knighthawks, Toronto Rock and Washington Stealth.
