Burnaby Mountain Selects announce 2011 Fall Rosters and Schedule

Burnaby Mountain Selects Lacrosse

BURNABY, BC (October 21, 2011) – Brent Hoskins, Head Coach of the Simon Fraser University (MCLA Div. I) Men's Lacrosse team and one of the founders of the Burnaby Mountain Lacrosse Elite Development Program, has announced the 2011 fall rosters and schedule for the Burnaby Mountain Selects (BMS) Elite Touring Teams. Entering the programs tenth season; the Burnaby Mountain Selects are widely recognized as one of Canada's top field lacrosse development programs, combining excellence on the field, with the importance of academic achievement. The Selects were established in 2006 using the same template as a university lacrosse program, designed to train players in a high performance environment to best prepare them for a collegiate field lacrosse career.

Burnaby Mountain will field eight travel teams this fall: Boys U11 Elite (Grad 2018, 2019), Boys U12 Elite (Grad 2017), Boys U13 Elite (Grad 2016), Boys Freshmen Elite (Grad 2015), Boys Sophomore Elite (Grad 2014), Boys Junior Elite (Grad 2013), Boys Senior Elite (Grad 2012) and Girls High School Elite (Grad 2012, 2013, 2014). In total, over one-hundred-and-fifty student-athletes from twenty-five different communities across British Columbia and Washington State will represent the Selects at top tournaments in California, Florida, Maryland, Nevada and North Carolina, as well as exhibition series in Oregon and Washington. Each team will attend multiple events, while also receiving organized tours of NCAA college campuses and enjoying additional city sites and attractions.

Hoskins is hands-on as Head Coach of all seven Boy's Elite teams, while the Select's inaugural Girl's Elite team is coached by former NCAA coach Chris Fox. Fox, currently an Assistant Coach of the SFU Men's Lacrosse team is involved with both the BMS Girl's and Boy's Elite teams, having previously served as Head Coach of the Men's Lacrosse program at Wheeling Jesuit University (NCAA Div. II) and an Assistant Coach of the Women's Lacrosse team at Whittier College (NCAA Div. III). Joining Hoskins and Fox on the Boy's Elite fall coaching staff are returning coaches Luke Genereux (Port Coquitlam, BC), and Chris Tessarolo (New Westminster, BC), as well as first-year coach Kyle Middleton (Nanaimo, BC). Genereux and Tessarolo are also Assistant Coaches at SFU, while Middleton is currently in his junior season as a goaltender for the Clan. Prior to coaching in Canada, Genereux was an Assistant Coach overseas at Bristol University (UK), while Middleton (BMS '09) and Tessarolo (BMS '07) joined the BMS coaching ranks after having both graduated from the Burnaby Mountain Selects program. Fox is assisted by former Team Canada goaltender Stephanie Burlton on the Girl's Elite Coaching Staff. Burlton was formerly the Women's Goaltender Coach / Assistant at Emerson College (NCAA Div. III) in Boston, MA, in addition to coaching Varsity High School Girl's Lacrosse in upstate New York.

The Girl's High School Elite team attends weekly practice consisting of an hour and a half Study Hall followed by a two-hour on-field practice. The BMS Girl's will commence their travel season with an exhibition series versus other Pacific Northwest regional all-star teams in Seattle on Sunday, October 23 before travelling to California, January 11-16 to showcase their talents at the Sand Storm Lacrosse Festival. The Sand Storm Lacrosse Festival will take place January 14 and 15 at the Empire Polo Club, a 20-field complex nestled in the Palm Springs desert valley below the picturesque San Jacinto Mountains. The well-known recruiting tournament will feature 80-plus girl's teams across four divisions. While in California, the Selects Girl's Elite team will also tour the University of Southern California (NCAA Div. I), Occidental College (NCAA Div. III) and Whittier College (NCAA Div. III), during an overnight stay in Los Angeles.

The Boy's U11, U12 and U13 fall season consists of one on-field practice each week with trips to Tacoma, WA on November 13 and Portland, OR, November 26-27, for exhibition contests versus regional all-star teams. The U11 and U13 Selects will then conclude their season with a trip to Las Vegas, Nevada, December 1-5, to compete at the Adrenaline Sin City Showdown, while the BMS U12 team will travel to Palm Springs, California, January 11-16 to compete at the Sand Storm Lacrosse Festival. The Sin City Showdown will take place December 3 and 4 at Star Nursery Field at

the University of Nevada Las Vegas' (UNLV) Sam Boyd Stadium, just two blocks off the world famous Las Vegas strip and featuring top Middle School and Youth teams from around the Western US. At Sand Storm, the U12 Selects will compete amongst 40-plus teams in the five division boy's bracket.

Burnaby Mountain's Boy's high school aged teams (Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior) practice on-field twice a week and attend three hours of weekly study hall. In addition to a three-month practice schedule, each team will compete in two top college recruiting events throughout North America. Each tournament will feature elite high-school aged competition from across the continent with the opportunity to play in front of NCAA and MCLA College recruiters.

The Freshmen and Junior Selects will kick off the Boy's 2011 fall season with a trip to North Carolina, October 27-31, to compete in the Charlotte Fall Classic. While visiting the "Old North State" the Selects will tour the campuses of NCAA Division I lacrosse powers North Carolina and Duke and feel the thrill of a speedway tour at the Charlotte Motor Speedway, home of the prestigious NASCAR Coca-Cola 600 on Memorial Day weekend and the Sprint All-Star Race.

The following weekend, November 2-7, the Senior team will travel to Baltimore, MD to compete in the Fall Invitational, hosted by legendary NCAA Coach Dave Cottle. In addition to the two-day recruiting showcase, the Selects will tour the University of Maryland (NCAA Div. I) and also take day trips to both Washington, DC and Manhattan, New York. While in the nation's capital, the Selects will visit historic attractions such as the White House, Lincoln Memorial and Washington Monument, while their day in the Big Apple will include stops at Times Square, Rockefeller Plaza, Ground Zero and Battery Park.

Two weeks later, November 16-21, the Freshmen and Sophomore Selects will return to Baltimore, Maryland to compete in Days 3 and 4 of the Ultimate Performance Lacrosse (UP Lax) Fall Shootout. On top of two days of competition which will conclude the Freshmen Elite season, the Selects will tour the campus of Georgetown University, the oldest Catholic University in the United States and home of the Hoyas men's lacrosse team (NCAA Div. I) and also enjoy day trips to both Washington, DC and Manhattan, New York.

Taking a short break for Christmas, the Selects will then be back on the road December 27 to January 3, as the Senior Elite team concludes their season in Tampa, Florida to compete at the nationally renowned Dick's Sporting Goods NDP Tournament of Champions. Teams are selected to compete at the Tournament of Champions by invitation only with an emphasis on assembling the top high school aged club teams in North America. The BMS 2012 class will be the fifth Burnaby Mountain team to compete in the prestigious three-day event, December 30 to January 1, for the coveted TOC National Championship.

In the New Year, the Sophomore and Junior elite squads will conclude the Boy's fall season when they travel to San Diego, California to compete for the western club championship at the Adrenaline Challenge. This event is expected to feature approximately 70 teams from every pocket of lacrosse in the West with over 75 NCAA college coaches in attendance. After two days of elite caliber lacrosse, the Selects will take time to have some fun in the sun at San Diego's popular Mission Beach.
