## **BMS Grads Delaney, Lachlan and McDermott Named Preseason NCAA All-Americans by Inside Lacrosse (ESPN)**

**BURNABY, BC** (December 12, 2011) – Burnaby Mountain Selects products James Delaney (Port Coquitlam, BC / St. Thomas More Collegiate), Richard Lachlan (Port Coquitlam, BC / Terry Fox Secondary) and Danny McDermott (Richmond, BC / Matthew McNair Secondary) have been named as Preseason NCAA All-Americans, as selected by Inside Lacrosse (ESPN Affiliate) in their recently released Face-off Yearbook. Delaney garnered second team honors and McDermott earned honorable mention status in NCAA Division II, while Lachlan was an honorable mention in NCAA Division III. Delaney was also named a preseason 1st team All East Coast Conference (ECC) selection by Inside Lacrosse (IL).

The Face-Off Yearbook NCAA Preseason All-Americans reflect a consensus of Inside Lacrosse staff and contributors, with consultation from dozens of college coaches around the country. The selection marks the second straight year that Delaney has earned preseason All-American recognition from IL as he makes the jump to the second team after receiving an honorable mention as a sophomore a year ago. Lachlan and McDermott both earn preseason honors for the first time in their collegiate careers following strong campaigns in 2011.

Delaney, a 2009 graduate of the Burnaby Mountain Selects program, will play his junior year during the upcoming 2012 season at Seton Hill University (NCAA Div. II) in Greensburg, Pennsylvania. Through two seasons with the Griffins, Delaney has scored an impressive 47 goals and 33 assists for 80 points in 28 games. In 2011, Delaney's 2.64 points-per-game placed him 45th nationally in NCAA Div. II, earning him a second team All ECC selection and honorable mention All-American honors last season. The Port Coquitlam, BC native played three seasons with Burnaby Mountain from 2008-2009, helping lead the Selects to successful tournaments in Colorado, Florida, Maryland and New York, including second place finishes at the 2008 Hobart College Team Camp and 2009 NDP Atlantic Cup.

Lachlan (BMS '09), a junior in 2012 at Roanoke College (NCAA Div. III) in Salem, Virginia was voted to the second team in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) last season, while finishing 33rd in NCAA Division III in goals-per-game (2.71). Lachlan earned his first all-conference honor as he lead the ODAC in goals (57), goals-per-game (2.71) and game-winning goals (6), while finishing ranked second in the conference in total points (68) and fifth in points-per-game (3.24). Starting all 21 games for the Maroons in 2011, he was also named ODAC Player of the Week on April 4. Through two NCAA seasons, the Port Coquitlam native has tallied 95 goals and 20 assists for 115 points in 42 games. Lachlan played four seasons for the Selects from 2006-2008, travelling to California, Colorado, Maryland, New York and Washington, winning Gold at the 2006 Space Needle Shootout and 2008 World Youth Invitational, placing second at the 2008 Hobart College Team Camp and reaching the Semi-Finals of the 2008 Adrenaline Challenge.

McDermott, a 2010 BMS grad, was one of only five sophomores to be named a Preseason All-American in NCAA Division II, sharing the honors with a total of 1 grad student, 20 seniors and 16 juniors. Entering his second year at the New York Institute of Technology – NYIT (NCAA Div. II) in Old Westbury, Long Island, McDermott receives his first collegiate recognition with the Bears, after recently being named to the 2012 Canada U19 Men's Field National Team that will represent Canada following the upcoming NCAA season at the 2012 FIL U19 Men's Field World Championship, July 12-21 in Turku, Finland. The Richmond, BC native played four seasons with BMS from 2007-2010 representing the Selects at tournaments in California, Colorado, Florida, Maryland and New York, winning Gold at the 2008 World Youth Invitational, placing second at the 2008 Hobart College Team Camp and reaching the Semi-Finals of the 2008 Adrenaline Challenge.

The 2012 NCAA Men's Lacrosse season kicks-off in February with NYIT beginning their regular season on February 17 by visiting Notre Dame de Namur, followed by Seton Hill hosting Lemoyne on February 18 and Roanoke hosting St. Mary's College on February 19.
